

KODIAK ADA IMPROVEMENTS Segment 5, Rezanof Drive State Project #SFHWY00433 • Federal Project #0011050


Project Summary

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is proposing to provide a continuous accessible route along the north side of Rezanof Drive between Marine Way and Benny Benson Drive, a 2-mile-long corridor in the City of Kodiak. Currently, this stretch of Rezanof Drive includes narrow sidewalk widths, excessive cross slopes and numerous curb ramps not compliant with standards required in the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Construction is anticipated to commence in phases starting in 2026 and continuing in 2027

Purpose of This Public Meeting The public meeting is to provide an opportunity for the public and adjacent property owners to learn about the proposed project improvements, ask questions, voice their opinions, communicate concerns, and provide any recommendations. The public meeting allows the project team to gain a better understanding of the community's interests, in return the design will be more effective and have responsive solutions from the community's comments.
